Conduct and Participation Guidelines in Beloura Golf Club Tournaments

I - GENERAL INFORMATION

- Mandatory social distance of 2 meters in the entire space of the Course and facilities.
- The use of a mask inside the Club House is mandatory.
- Access to the Shop / Reception is allowed, but with LIMITED access to 3 people inside.
- Bathhouses closed.
- W.C.'s available on both floors
- Restaurant Bar 19 is open with the rules imposed by DGS
- You must not participate in the tournament if:
 - Traveled to countries at risk in the last 14 days
 - You have or have had a fever, cough or breathing problem in the last 14 days
 - Was in contact (unprotected) with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- You must notify the club if you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of participating in the tournament.

II - PARTICIPANTS

All players who are members of the Club, Beloura Pestana Golfe subscribers and their guests can participate in the Tournaments provided they fulfill the handicap limits and are federated by F.P.G. or another with a valid handicap.

III - REGISTRATION

Beginning of Registration will be transmitted to members by email, club page or Facebook.

Tournament registration can be done within 48 hours of the Tournament:

In the last case, you can register at the Reception

Buggies will be available for booking, but can only be used by one player or shared by players from the same house.

If you have not previously registered, participation in the tournament is not authorized.

The departures will be successive from tee 1 and the draw will be made by DATAGOLF.

Failure to appear in the tournament without 24-hour notice or without force majeure, accepted by the club's management, penalizes the player by inability to register for the next tournament.

IV - PAYMENT / CHECK-IN

Payment must be made in cash (we will try to find a solution for electronic payment).

In order to avoid crowding on the day of the tournament, only 3 people are allowed inside the Reception at a time.

You must pay / check in the tournament up to 30 to 20 minutes before your departure.

Payment for registration on the day of the tournament must be made in exact amount.

You must arrive equipped for the practice of Golf, changing rooms are closed.

Do not stay at the Club Reception for longer than necessary.

V - SOCIALIZATION

- There will be no lunch, nor the usual fraternization and prize giving until it is safe

VI - SCORE CARDS

Score cards will be printed the day before, cleaned and delivered at check-in / departure tee.

The player with the lowest handicap receives a card where he will introduce the results of all the players in his formation.

Each player must write down his individual card for later conference with the card of his formation.

VII - WARM UP AREAS

The player's warm-up must take place between the 20 minutes before the departure time.

The putting and chipping areas are open, however they are limited in number of users and the social physical distance of 2 meters must always be respected.

In the driving range, it is mandatory to respect spaces that are prohibited.

VIII -STARTING TEE

Arrival at the starting tee must not be made if the players from the previous formation are still in place.

Players must approach Tee 1 no later than 5 minutes before their departure time, unless the Starter calls.

Players must not greet each other physically at any time during the event, before during or after

Exchanging cards is prohibited.



IX - WHILE PLAYING

Social distance will be monitored

Players cannot share / exchange material or equipment, namely balls, tees, gloves, pitch repairs, ball markers, distance meters, etc. ...

Only the player himself can, lift, drop and place his own ball.

Bunkers do not lose their condition, and Rule 12 remains in effect, without any changes, and bunkers ground must be smoothed with the club and / or feet.

It is forbidden to remove or touch the flag on the green.

For the hole to be considered completed, the ball must be inside the hole, over the depth gauge

The player must collect the ball from the hole with the greatest possible precaution.

Stools and ball washers are prohibited..

X -END GAME

Players should not greet each other physically.

Players must leave the green at hole 18 immediately.

The results conference must be held in front of the club-house. As soon as possible

As soon as possible the player must remove his equipment from the club-house area.

XI - CARD DELIVERY:

At the end of the round, players must confirm the results verbally with their partners

No card should be signed.

The card with all results must be photographed by all players

The Card must be sent to the reception by email to sulina.gomes@pestana.com within 15 minutes

Results are considered delivered when sent by the player responsible for the formation.

XII - FINAL RESULTS

-Results will be published within 24 to 48 hours.

After receiving the results, each player has 4 hours to claim the results.

FINAL NOTES

– Failure to comply with any of the rules implemented by the club, “Recommendations of the golf facilities reopening plan” and current DGS indications incurs the following penalties, according to the FPG Code of Conduct:

First offense: Verbal warning

Second offense: General Penalty (Two strokes in Strokplay or Loss of Hole in Match Play)

The unintentional act is not penalized
