



8th Order of Merit – Magusto Tournament November 2, 2024

PARTICIPATION

-The tournament is open to members and guests of the Beloura Golf Club with a valid WHS handicap and a minimum age of 12 years.

COMPETITION FORMAT

- Format: Stableford 95%

One round of 18 holes.

- Men: Teeing off from the yellow tees, with a maximum playing handicap of 28 WHS.
- Ladies: Teeing off from the red tees, with a maximum playing handicap of 36 WHS.

SCORING AND ORDERS OF MERIT

-Results will count towards the 2024 Orders of Merit, both in the Net and Gross categories.

CATEGORIES AND PRIZES

General: All players aged 24 or older not included in the following categories:

- Juniors (Under-14, Under-18, and Under-24): These categories will only be considered if 3 or more players in each category complete the event.
- Ladies: The prize will be awarded to the top-ranked player if 3 or more players finish the event. Otherwise, they will be integrated into the general classification.
- Guests: Guests will only be eligible for prizes and competition if 3 or more players complete the event.

RULES

-The rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews (R&A), local rules of Pestana Beloura Golf, and specific tournament rules apply.

TIEBREAKERS

- Gross: will be determined by the best last 9, 6, 3, and final hole (of the course) scores. If still tied, the higher handicap wins, followed by a draw.
- Net: will follow the same procedure. However, if still tied, the lower handicap wins, followed by a draw.

REGISTRATION

-Registration deadline: Until October 31 at 2:00 PM.

Limited to 72 players.

-Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Entries after the deadline will not be considered.





ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Check-in: From 7:30 AM.
- Players must be at the tee 10 minutes before their scheduled time.
- The use of distance measuring devices is allowed.
- Golf carts are permitted.
- The draw will be made randomly.
- The prize ceremony will be held during lunch at the Clubhouse restaurant.

PRIZES

-PERFORMANCE PRIZES:

Gross Classification: 1st place

Net Classification: 1st and 2nd places

Other Net Prizes: 1st Net Women, Juniors, and Guests (if 3 players finish the event in each category).

-SKILL PRIZES

Nearest the Pin: Holes 3 and 5

Note 1: There will be no accumulation of prizes; the Gross prize takes precedence over the Net. For the 1st Net Women, this prize takes precedence over the general classification.

Note 2: Sponsor prizes will only be awarded to players present at the ceremony during lunch at the Clubhouse restaurant.

LUNCH, PRIZE CEREMONY, AND TOMBOLA

-Starts at 1:30 PM at the Clubhouse restaurant

MENU: Couvert, "Sopa de Pedra", Desert, drinks, and coffe.

Note 3: If fewer than 16 players confirm their participation for lunch by the registration deadline, the prize ceremony will be held at the end of the year, with a date to be announced later.
