



### **Order of Merit 2025 Regulations**

The Order of Merit 2025 of the Clube de Golfe da Beloura (ACGB), hereinafter referred to as CGB, aims to promote competitive spirit and camaraderie among CGB members and annual subscribers of Pestana Beloura Golf.

#### **1. Participation**

Participation is reserved for members of the Clube de Golfe da Beloura and annual subscribers of Pestana Beloura Golf who are duly registered with the Portuguese Golf Federation, with active status and a valid WHS handicap.

#### **2. Super Senior Players**

Super senior players aged 75 or older as of December 31, 2024, may opt to compete from the red tees. However:

- If the player chooses to play from the yellow tees, their scores will count toward the Men's Gross and Net categories.
- If the player chooses to compete from the red tees, their scores will not count toward the general men's Order of Merit classification but will only be valid for the Super Senior classification.
- The choice of tee markers must remain consistent throughout the entire Order of Merit season, and alternating tee markers during the year will not be allowed for classification purposes.

#### **3. Tournaments and Super Senior Order of Merit**

For the Super Senior classification to be considered in a tournament, at least 3 players in this category must complete the event. In such cases, prizes will be awarded for both Net and Gross classifications.

For Super Senior Order of Merit prizes to be awarded at the end of the season, at least 8 players must participate throughout the season.

#### **4. Order of Merit Categories**

The Order of Merit will be contested in the following categories:

- Men's Gross
- Women's Gross
- Men's Net
- Women's Net
- Super Senior Gross
- Super Senior Net

#### **5. Eligible Tournaments for the Order of Merit**

The Order of Merit classification will consider results obtained in the following tournaments:

Alex Rodrigues Memorial – January 11th

Captains Day – February 15th

3rd Order of Merit Tournament – March 22nd

4th Order of Merit Tournament – April 12th

Beloura Cup – June 7th

6th Order of Merit Tournament – July 5th

President's Putter – October 4th

Club Anniversary Tournament – November 1st



**6. Classifications**

The classification will be determined by the sum of points obtained in the Gross and Net categories, considering:

- The best 3/4 of the tournaments held, rounded down, up to a maximum of 6 results;
- A minimum of 4 participations is required for classification purposes.

**7. Tiebreaker Criteria**

Ties will be resolved successively as follows:

In Gross, in favor of the higher handicap, and in Net, in favor of the lower handicap, as of the date of the last eligible tournament;

Greater number of participations in the tournaments held;

Greater number of victories;

Best result in the last eligible tournament in which the tied players participated.

Prizes will not be cumulative, with the Gross prize taking precedence over the Net prize.

However, a player who appears in both Orders of Merit (Gross and Net) shall receive the prize corresponding to the **highest position achieved** — that is, the **better of the two classifications**.

**8. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in the Gross and Net categories:

**Men and Women**

1st Gross

2nd Gross

3rd Gross

1st Net

2nd Net

3rd Net

**Super Senior**

1st Gross

1st Net

**9. Honor Roll**

Only players whose handicap is managed by the Clube de Golfe da Beloura will be included in the Honor Roll.

**10. Regulation Amendments**

The CGB Board reserves the right to amend or supplement this regulation at any time, whenever deemed necessary.
