



Order of Merit Regulations 2026

The 2026 Order of Merit of the Beloura Golf Club (ACGB), hereinafter referred to as CGB, aims to promote a competitive spirit and social interaction among CGB members, subscribers of Pestana Beloura Golf and their guests.

1. Participation

Participation is open to Members of the Beloura Golf Club, annual subscribers of Pestana Beloura Golf, and their guests, duly registered with the Portuguese Golf Federation, holding active status and a valid WHS handicap.

2. Super Senior Players

Super senior players, aged 75 years or older as of December 31, 2025, may choose to compete from the red tees. However:

If the player chooses to play from the yellow tees, their scores will be considered for the Men's Gross and Net category rankings.

If the player chooses to compete from the red tees, their scores will not be considered for the overall Men's Order of Merit ranking, being valid only for the Super Senior classification.

The choice of tee markers must be maintained throughout the entire Order of Merit season, and alternating between tee markers during the year for ranking purposes is not permitted.

3. Tournaments and Order of Merit

For a tournament classification to be considered, 3 or more players in the category must complete the competition. In such cases, prizes will be awarded for the Net and Gross classifications.

For Order of Merit prizes to be awarded at the end of the season, participation of 8 or more players throughout the season is required.

4. Order of Merit Categories

The Order of Merit will be contested in the following categories:

- Men's Gross
- Ladies' Gross
- Men's Net
- Ladies' Net
- Super Senior Gross
- Super Senior Net
- Guest Gross
- Guest Net

5. Tournaments Eligible for the Order of Merit

The Order of Merit ranking will take into account the results obtained in the following tournaments:

4ª OM Clube	18th April
Taça Beloura (5ª OM)	20th June
6ª OM Clube	4th July
President's putter (7ª OM)	10th October
Torneio de Aniversário (8ª OM)	31st October

6. Rankings

The rankings will be determined by the sum of the points obtained in the Gross and Net categories, considering:

- The best 3/4 of the tournaments played, rounded down, up to a maximum of 6 results;
- A minimum of 4 participations for ranking purposes.

7. Tie-Break Criteria

In the event of a tie in the final Order of Merit ranking, prizes shall not be cumulative, with the Gross prize prevailing over the Net prize. Tie-breaks will be resolved successively as follows:

In Gross, in favor of the higher handicap, and in Net, in favor of the lower handicap, as of the date of the last eligible tournament;

Greater number of participations in the tournaments played;

Greater number of wins;

Best result in the last eligible tournament in which the tied players participated.

8. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in the following Gross and Net categories:

4. Hall of Fame

Only players whose handicap is managed by the Beloura Golf Club will be included in the Hall of Fame, and always those who achieved the best classification prior to the application of the tie-break criteria.
